GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS SONG COVER, DANCE, AND ORAL SPEECH COMPETITION

A. CONTESTANTS

1. Participants are active students from study programs in universities.
2. Participants are individuals.
3. A participants is just allowed to join a category.
4. Participants are students who have been registered by their respective universities.
5. Overseas participants MUST provide student identification, a passport and student card. The identity can be submitted together with the participants the contested works.
6. Each participant must fill in the registration form provided by the committee.
7. Registration form can be filled in via google form with the address: <http://bit.ly/ICOHEX2022>.
8. Submitting the contested creation is no later than May 27th, 2022 at 23.59 WIB
9. Announcement of the winners for all categories will be announced on May 31st, 2022.
10. The contested creations must be original creation that have never been published and have not been included in other competitions.
11. The contested creations do not contain elements of SARA, pornography, violence, and do not conflict with applicable norms.
12. The contested creations will become the committee's property of the committee and can be published for the interests/ activities of Duta Bangsa Surakarta University.
13. The decision of the jury cannot be contested.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SONG COVER COMPETITION

A. TECHNICAL TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. Each participant is allowed to send only one song.
2. Song cover participants must use English.
3. Participants may only sing "Solo" or Individuals, not "Duet", "Trio", or others.
4. Participants may be accompanied by other people to accompany the music.
5. Participants are prohibited hard to LipSync.
6. Participants cover 1 free song, chosen by each participant (Genre: Free, Mandatory in English).
7. The duration of the video is a maximum of 5 minutes and the video can use any camera.
8. Video in the form of mp4 (filename.mp4), Quicktime Movie (filename.mov), or FLV (filename.flv), with a minimum resolution of 720p.
9. Then the video is sent to <http://bit.ly/ICOHEX2022> by renaming the file name: Song Cover_Name of Participant _Name of Institution_Title of song cover.

B. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Assessment based on:

➤ Vocal Skills

1. Voice intonation/ pitch control
2. Breathing
3. Cutting off breath
4. Articulation/ diction/ pronunciation
5. Accuracy of tempo
6. Use of a, i, u, e, o
7. The appropriateness of using resonance

➤ **Song Interpretation**

1. The climax of the song / the dynamics of the song
2. Improvisation
3. Accuracy of song interpretation
4. Deepening of appreciation
5. Musicality (harmony with musicl accompaniment, etc.)

➤ **Expression**

➤ **Performance**

1. Discipline and order
2. Stage action
3. Neatness

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF DANCE COMPETITION

A. TECHNICAL TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. Each participant is allowed to send only 1 (one) dance video.
2. The dance video works are accompanied by English music.
3. Participants may only dance “Solo” or Individuals, not “Duet”, “Trio”, or others.
4. Participants may be accompanied by other people as musical accompaniment.
5. The duration of the video is a maximum of 5 minutes and the video can use any camera.
6. Video in the form of mp4 (filename.mp4), Quicktime Movie (filename.mov), or FLV (filename.flv), with a minimum resolution of 720p.
7. Then the video is sent to http://bit.ly/ICOHEX2022_by renaming the file name: Dance_Participant Name_Institution Name_Dance title.

B. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Assessment based on:

1. Theme Match
2. Originality
3. Message Power
4. Video Quality
5. Creativity

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ORAL SPEECH COMPETITION

A. TECHNICAL TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. Participants must use formal English when giving a speech.
2. Participants wear casual and polite clothes.
3. Participants are required to make a speech in accordance with the theme that has been determined by the committee, namely "Optimization of Stunting Prevention to Invest in Achievers Generation".
4. During the speech, participants are not allowed to bring speech texts, except for small notes containing pin points and supporting text for the speech (such as: evidence in the form of graphics, photos and so on)
5. The duration of the speech is 5 minutes to 7 minutes.
6. Speeches can be recorded using any camera.
7. Video speech in the form of mp4 (filename.mp4), Quicktime Movie (filename.mov), or FLV (filename.flv), with a minimum resolution of 720p.
8. Then the video is sent to http://bit.ly/ICOHEX2022_ by renaming the file name: Oral Speech_Participant Name_Institution Name_Title of oral speech.

B. PROVISIONS OF THE TEXT TERMS

1. Speech manuscripts are scripts that have never been used in any speech competition before.
2. If it is violated, the participant will get a deduction according to the judge's decision.
3. The speech manuscript is an original manuscript made by the participants and is not the result of plagiarism. If violated, the participant will be disqualified.
4. The speech is typed in English using the font "Times New Roman" size 12 with 1.5 spacing and using A4 size.
5. The manuscripts must be submitted to the committee along with sending a video speech.

C. ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

1. Relevance, namely the suitability of the content of the manuscript with the theme.
2. Argumentation, which is the logic flow used in the script.
3. Coherence of ideas, namely the integration of ideas between sentences and between paragraphs.
4. Diction, namely the level of formality of the vocabulary used in the text.
